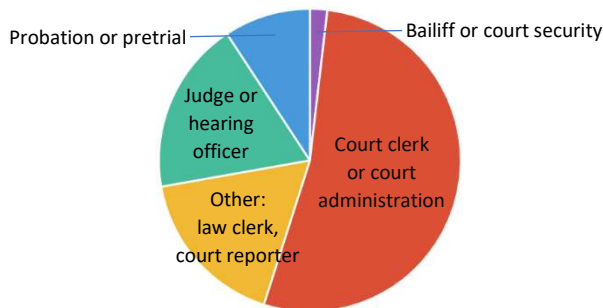
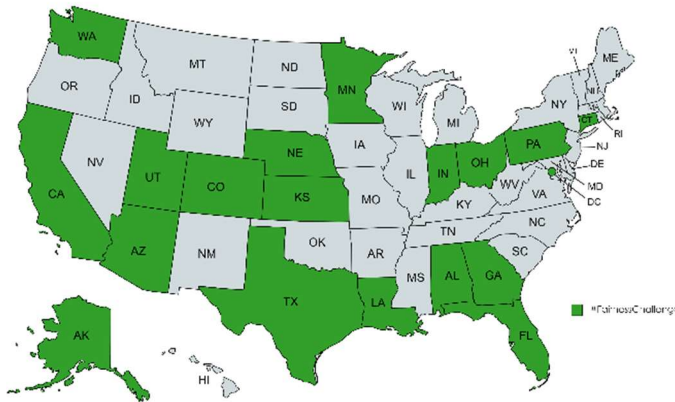


#FairnessChallenge 2021

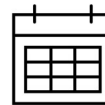
Who participated

over 70 courts nationally*



190+ judges and court professionals from 3 courts

A 12-session, 4-week remote **teeny course**
asking for and reporting out participant
insights along the way



495 judges and court professionals from **68** courts

Daily “fairness exercises” over 4 weeks
guided by an **exercise calendar**

What participants said about it

- **"The course turns well-intentioned theory into boots-on-the-ground change"**
